ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY

Attendance is monitored.

Please be punctual when dropping your child off and collecting.

Nursery times are:

- AM session- 8.30am- 11.30am (gates open at 11.15am)
- PM session- 12.15pm – 3.15pm (gates open at 3.00pm)
- 30 hour session 8.30am-3.15pm with a 45 minute lunch break

The gates will shut promptly at the end of each session. If your child has not been collected by 11.30am or 3.15pm, you will need to go to the school office and collect them from the late gate.



Reading with children at home

In the nursery we encourage parents to take a book home once a week.

Please can you ensure you read to your children for a minimum of 10 minutes every day to help build on their vocabulary. It will also help them learn the sounds in the spoken language (this is called phonological awareness).

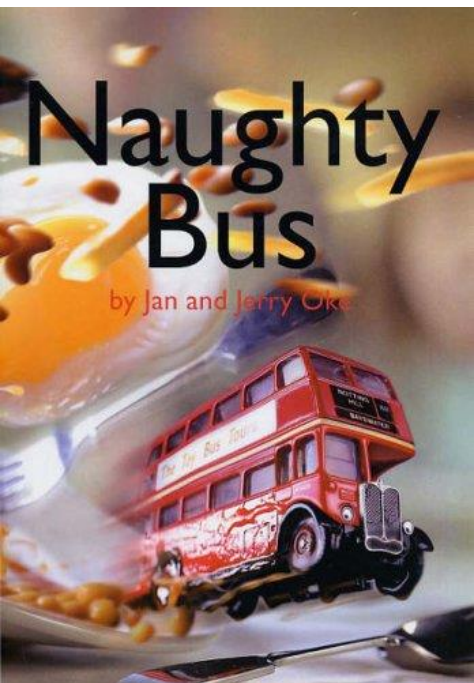
Ask your children lots of questions about the story book for example: -

- What did you like about the story?
